ABOUT THE FREE THATRE

The Free Theatre provides an inclusive, supportive environment in which passionate students have the opportunity to be at the helm of the collaborative and creative process of producing theatre, regardless of financial means. The Free Theatre was formed in June 2018 by a small group of dedicated high school seniors with the desire and drive to create a non-profit 501(c)3, student-run, tuition-free company for students who are passionate about creating theatre.

"It's a cautionary tale," Janis Sarkisian sings in the opening minutes of Mean Girls. But that's not the real world—fortunately, the social terror of The Plastics remains stowed in our scripts. Bringing a high school narrative to a high school group was an adventure that proved to be far more challenging than it had seemed. This company has pushed through the harsh truths and challenging themes of the no-holds-barred depiction of high school that is Mean Girls. Its explorations of kindness, friendship, and finding your identity are brutally honest, which is what I love about this show. And though this story is evergreen, I hope you'll be able to take away a new sweet moment from this performance, or just revel in the glory of your high school days (past or yet to come). But in the end, I hope you'll be reminded that though "mean is easier than nice," kindness is always the best way forward.




